## From the Missions Ministry

### **Lifeline Christian Missions**

Lifeline Christian Mission seeks to fulfill a two-fold purpose:

-Take the Good News of Jesus Christ to a lost and dying world.

-Teach home Christians God's will concerning mission responsibility.

As we accomplish this purpose, Jesus Christ remains the central focus of all we do.

An African proverb says: "Smooth seas do not make skillful sailors." We are made better by what we experience with God leading us through the rough seas.

It took a diagnosis of Stage IV malignant melanoma to lead Bob DeVoe back to Christ. Given no more than 60 days to live, he gave those days to Jesus. He experienced physical and spiritual healing through Christ. He grew in his faith. During a mission trip, he and his family fell in love with Haiti. Bob accepted God's call and Lifeline Christian Mission was founded. That was November 1980. The Mission expanded into Honduras in 1986. Cuba became a part of the ministry in 2004 and El Salvador in 2005.

The Mission is aligned with non-denominational independent Christian Churches and Churches of Christ. Ministry programs include every aspect of human needs. Sponsorship programs, churches, schools, emergency relief, food and clothing pantries, health care, housing, nutrition, orphanages, evangelism, leadership development, vocational programs and mission trips are some but not all of the Mission's outreaches.

There are 9,000 + children who receive an education from Lifeline's 15 Christian schools. About 15,000 people receive medical and dental care annually, and 6,200 souls are fed daily. There are 24 houses constructed annually in Haiti. Earthquake relief efforts are continuing in Haiti. Lifeline Christian Mission is proclaiming the Good News abroad and teaching the Great Commission at home, while centering Jesus Christ in all "Kingdom Building" activities.

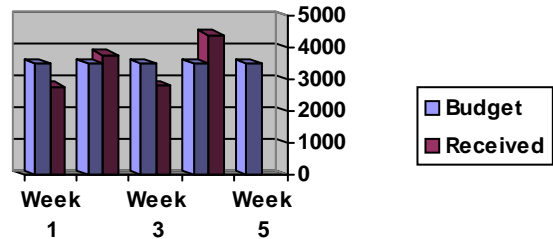
